GUIDELINES FOR WRITING AND SUBMITTING ABSTRACTS

Active participants of the congress will present their papers through oral presentations, limited to 15 minutes.

When submitting abstracts, please note the following:

- It is possible to submit up to three papers per presenting author, who must always be clearly indicated.
- Co-authorship is limited to three submitted papers.
- Each paper may have a maximum of five authors (including co-authors).

Anyone wishing to submit and present a paper at the Symposium must send:

- The title of the paper and the abstract
- Deadline: September 30, 2025
- Email address: hidorahimic@gmail.com

Abstracts must be prepared in MS Office Word, in Calibri font (default font for MS Office 2007 and later versions), font size 12, with line spacing 1.5. The title should clearly reflect the content of the paper.

The list of authors must clearly indicate the presenting author, as well as the institutions/organizations they represent.

The abstract text must:

- Be written in the languages of the peoples of Bosnia and Herzegovina and in English
- Have a maximum of 250 words
- Be structured to include: introduction, materials and methods, results, and conclusion
- End with up to 5 keywords

After submission, abstracts will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee of the Congress. Authors will be notified of acceptance no later than October 15, 2025.

After the congress, all abstracts will be published in an electronic Book of Abstracts, which will be available to every Symposium participant.
